**9:00 – 12:00pm: “Firefighter Rehabilitation and Medical Monitoring: A Guide to NFPA 1584”**  
– *Bryan Bledsoe, DO, FACEP, FAAEM*

Dr. Bryan Bledsoe is Clinical Professor of Emergency Medicine and Director of the Pre hospital and Disaster Medicine Fellowship at the University of Nevada School of Medicine, as well as a board-certified emergency physician at University Medical Center in Las Vegas. Dr. Bledsoe has served as the Medical Director for two hospital emergency departments as well as for numerous EMS agencies. He is the author of numerous EMS textbooks including: *Paramedic Care: Principles & Practice*, *Paramedic Emergency Care*, *Prehospital Emergency Pharmacology*, *Anatomy and Physiology for Emergency Care* and many others. He is a frequent contributor to EMS magazines and presenter at national and international EMS conferences.

**2:30 to 3:30pm: “Can Oxygen Really be Bad?”**  
– *Bryan Bledsoe, DO, FACEP, FAAEM*

Oxygen therapy has been a mainstay in emergency medicine for many years. However, recent and evolving research has started to question whether high-concentration oxygen may be harmful. This primarily results from the induction of oxygen-free radicals that develop when tissues are reperfused. This presentation will provide a brief overview of the concept of free radicals including the importance of oxidative stress. This will then be followed by a discussion of EMS implications of this new knowledge.
